Many of the youth who arrive at Home of the Innocents come with very few personal belongings—sometimes with only the clothes on their backs. During times of crisis, transition, or emergency placement, access to basic clothing can provide immediate comfort, dignity, and a sense of security.

Suggested Clothing Donations

To help meet the immediate needs of children, teens, and young adults entering care, we are seeking **new, unused clothing items** that are practical, comfortable, and appropriate for everyday wear.

Our goal is to help provide enough essential clothing to support a child or young person during their first **24 to 48 hours** in care. These items can make a tremendous difference during a difficult and often overwhelming transition.

Most Requested Items

- T-Shirts
- Hoodies
- Sweatpants
- Jackets
- Socks
- Pajamas

Additional Essential Items

- Comfortable pants or jeans
- Long-sleeve shirts
- New, unopened undergarments
- Athletic wear
- Seasonal outerwear
- Basic everyday outfits for school, work, and daily activities

When possible, consider donating enough items to help create a 24- to 48-hour clothing package, such as:

- 2–3 shirts
- 1–2 pairs of pants or sweatpants
- 1 hoodie or jacket
- 2–3 pairs of socks
- 1 set of pajamas
- New undergarments

These basic necessities help provide comfort, confidence, and dignity to young people during a critical time in their lives. What may seem like a simple donation can help a child feel safe, cared for, and prepared for the days ahead.
